

CrossWay International's Strategy

CrossWay International focuses on a number of areas as a means of outreach.

Water Well Drilling—We have drilled wells in Sudan (near Darfur), Kenya, Ethiopia, Tanzania, and we have plans to drill more in other parts of Africa and Central America.

Orphans—We support orphans and needy kids in Ethiopia, Liberia, Kenya, and other countries as we encounter them. We help provide food, shelter, and schooling if possible.



Medical Clinics—One of our medical clinics, which we recently established, is specifically for these orphans. We are opening a second medical clinic in Meki, Ethiopia.

Schools—Our school in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, is self-supporting. A second school in Sudan is meeting the needs of the orphans there through the devotion of ten teachers, whom we support full-time.

Pastors' Conferences and Evangelistic Events—We sponsor pastors' conferences and evangelistic events in many parts of the world, including Sudan, Tanzania, Uganda, Ethiopia, Liberia, and Nicaragua to date.

CrossWay International was founded in 1997 by Dean and Joan Chollar, when they returned from Belgium where they had been missionaries for 11 years.

CrossWay International's main focus is on evangelistic work overseas. Dean Chollar has traveled to 50+ countries (in spite of his physical blindness) to share the gospel, lead evangelistic campaigns, preach and teach in various capacities, and to encourage local Christian leaders. In addition, CrossWay embraces opening doors for sharing the gospel through numerous overseas projects, including income-generating projects and providing critical aid to those in need.

We are also available to help the stateside churches with evangelistic materials, equipping seminars and teaching, preaching and motivational speaking.

As the ministry has grown, God has also brought alongside a gifted staff, and 4 new missionaries, in addition to our coworkers overseas.

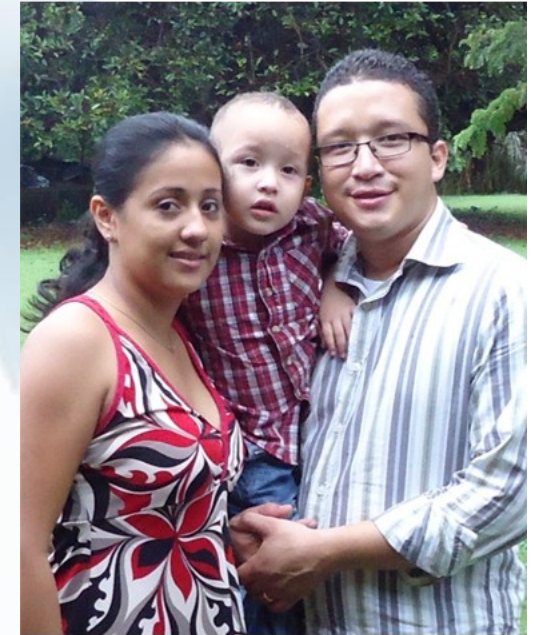

Personal History

Ali is the younger of two brothers, born in a Christian family in 1985. His father left his job as a diesel mechanic to start an association of Baptist churches in Nicaragua with some other brothers in the church. With the support of great missionary friends from the US, ACIBEN (Christian Association of Baptist Churches in Nicaragua) was founded, where his father is a pastor in the local church of Sébaco, town where they live.

Since 1993 his father and other members of ACIBEN have been traveling all over Nicaragua to set up ACIBEN, in the process Ali has been involved with teams from the US, building churches and doing street evangelism in different cities.

Ali went to school in Sébaco, and from 2003 to 2007 he went to college in Leon (Pacific Nicaragua) where he earned a B.A. in International Relations, with a specialty on Foreign Politics. This allowed him to learn English, a language that he has used since then to translate for missions trips from the U.S, pastors seminars, street evangelism, conferences and more. Ali is also working as President of the Youth Ministry of ACIBEN, leading week long youth camps once a year and making youth programs for the churches of their association.



In 2007 Ali got married with Carolina; they have a son named Roger Josias (3). His wife serves in their church as secretary and coworker for preschool kids in Sunday school.

Since 2009 Ali has been leading the Management Board for the school of his church, where they have

160 kids (49 with scholarships). The school teaches Bible education as its main importance since its foundation in 1996. The school also added English and computing class to his education program, being the only school in town teaching those classes. With this ministry Ali is more involved in education as he thinks that this is the only way to generate progress in society based on a Christian education.

Roger Ali has worked in a Bank since 2009 and his prayers are to leave his job and dedicate his time to serving GOD through the School, church and CWI, trusting that God will supply all his family needs as He has done until now, dedicating more time to the ministry as his father did, many years ago.

Roger Ali and Carolina's main responsibility will be to help coordinate and oversee the various ministries for CrossWay International. Our initial focus will be in Nicaragua, with the hope to expand to the rest of Central/South America.
