In July, and just a couple blocks from our Masaya Campus, Kevin was attacked and his phone was stolen. Just one month later while Kevin was driving, a stray horse ran out into the street and caused major damage to his vehicle. Thankfully no one was seriously injured. Even the horse seemed fine.
